Born in Sheridan, Wyoming into a ranching family, Karen began life as an incurable outdoors girl. She was on horseback from the beginning and made her love of horses into a lifelong career. She accomplished four qualifications to the National Finals Rodeo plus numerous futurity wins.

In 1987 a horse related accident sidelined her, resulting in the beginning of quite a successful sculpting career with sculptures sold and displayed throughout the U.S. and overseas. Keeping with the equine forum, she also includes other animals in her art. Karen say's "Sculpting is something I can completely lose myself in and hope to do forever."

Karen works in watercolor as well and began adding colored pencil to her work after taking a class by Phil Micheau at the HAA gallery. Working from home in Sierra Vista, AZ, she enjoys creating her own ideas and doing commissions.



advanced Drawing Classes

w/Nathaniel Zoret-Russell

Every Sunday 10 AM-12:15 PM

Minimum class size is 3, MAX class size is 20

\$15 per class

1 FREE class included if you buy a 10 class punch card: \$150

1st Sunday will be a lecture and micro study.
2nd Sunday will be a still life or live clothed model.
3rd Sunday will be a continuation of the last class.
No Class on the last Sunday of every month.
HAA uses this day to hang new work.

Class will take a deep dive into mastery level techniques with more advanced topics such as planar shapes, 3pt perspective and the nature of light; refraction, fresnel, inverse square law and reflected highlights.

Students would be encouraged to build a portfolio of sketches to show their growth. This class promises to be a challenge for those looking to make a noticeable improvement in their skills.



Supply List:

- 1 notepad
- 1 large pad of newsprint
- 1 large pad of mixed media paper, Bristol or drawing paper Vine charcoal

Compressed charcoal (8B, 6B, 2B, HB and 2H)

Charcoal pencil (8B, 6B, 2B, HB and 2H)

Kneadable eraser

Workable fixative

Drawing pencils in the following hardnesses (8B, 6B, 2B, HB and 2H)

*we will primarily be working in charcoal

Recommended Supplies:

- Pencil bag or bin for keeping pencils and charcoal separate
- Large portfolio capable of holding both pads of paper
- Sharpie, India ink or some form of true black
- White chalk pencil
- Mechanical eraser or eraser pencil
- Powdered charcoal and a soft water color brush
