
Darlene Wilkinson

President's Message

Happy Maytime, Artyfolks,

Well, for a few days last month it was spring. That didn't last long, and now, it's suddenly summer again. Just last week I had my first scorpion encounter of the season. It came about a month earlier than usual and after dark - two little ones, one following right after the other, parading right into my bedroom. Given how close together they came, I believe that they may have been in love – perhaps even looking to start a family. Well, they picked the wrong place for that, and as much as I hate to be the one to put the kibosh on young love, I grabbed a swatter and whacked them anyway. Clearly, the season for walking around barefoot in the dark is now officially over in my house, at least until next November, and it's time again to haul out the industrial grade bug spray. Soon, there'll be snakes.

Here's some good news from Jennifer Sorenson at the Sierra Vista Herald. They are initiating a new fund-raising project for the benefit of local non-profit organizations, and we will be Sierra Vista's first beneficiary. It will be a spiral bound booklet with perforated pages of postcards featuring reproductions of art pieces, mainly paintings and photographs, by local artists. There will be a competition to select the works to be featured on the cards. The paper will be in charge of the judging, and of course, while they are encouraging entries from the HAA, the competition will be open to everybody. They are planning to print 1000 copies that will be priced at \$10 each, and they will be for sale in our gallery and at Art in the Park, as well as in various other locations around town. For any booklets that we sell, we will get to keep the whole \$10. For any that are sold elsewhere, we will get \$5, and the other vendors will keep \$5. The Herald will recoup their costs by soliciting sponsors to run small ads on the reverse sides of the cards. The time for submitting entries will be short, and coming up very soon, so stay tuned for more information.

Congratulations to Martha Sprenkle, the winner of this year's Art in the Park insert/poster contest. Lois Bravo has put the poster up on our Art in the Park website (artintheparksierravista.com) and has been busy signing up vendors. It's looking very good so far, and again this year we will be doing a little mutual back scratching with the city of Sierra Vista. They will be sponsoring two Wine, Beer and Spirits Festivals in the park – the first one being on May 28, which is this Memorial Day weekend. The city has offered the HAA space in the festival area for five tents, at no cost to us, and we have vendors signed up to be there. Then on Saturday, October 1, they'll be sponsoring their second festival, along with us, at Art in the Park. So there'll be wine, beer, spirits, *and* ART! Great combination!

And speaking of festivals, this year we will have a vendor's table at the Southwest Wings Nature and Birding Festival at Cochise College in August. We will be looking for bird-related merchandise for display and for sale there. The space will be very limited, so smaller items would be the best – especially things that are suitcase sized. Also, for that month at the gallery, we will be featuring bird-related art, in addition to the work of the regular featured artists.

And speaking of featured artists, at the last meeting, the board decided that, instead of our usual practice of having one featured artist for one month, in the future, we would like to try having two featured artists for two months – as a general rule, one wall artist and one table artist. Given the amount of work required to put a show together, it only makes sense to allow more time, both for the artists and for the hanging crew. If you are a gallery artist and would like to be a featured artist, please let Sue Ziegler know.


Enjoy the summer weather! Watch out for snakes and scorpions, and don't do anything to make the killer bees mad!


