I am currently showing at the Huachuca Art Association Gallery in Sierra Vista AZ.

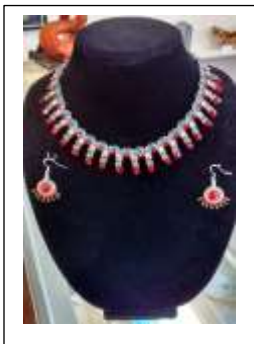

Jesse T. Hummingbird of Bisbee was selected as one of the ten Cherokee National Living Treasures of the Cherokee Nation to exhibit and demonstrate his art during the Cherokee Festival Days at the National Museum of the American Indian (NMAI) in Washington, DC, April 12-14. This festival brings together artists from the Cherokee Nation, the Eastern Band of Cherokee, and the United Keetoowah Band of Cherokee Indians partnering to share the Cherokee story... Jesse is a well-known American Indian artist, a painter, graphic artist and commercial illustrator, born in Tahlequah, OK, who became a full-time artist in 1983. His paintings depict Cherokee and other Native American themes; he also produces mixed media masks and giclee reproductions of his paintings. He has illustrated several children's books, holiday cards, and notecards. He has won many national awards and exhibits his work at shows across the southwest, including the annual Art in the Park in Sierra Vista.

Don't miss this year's **HAA picnic at the ranch on Sunday, June 23, taking place from 5:00 until dusk.** Due to seasonal fire restrictions, we cannot cook there, but the HAA will be providing sandwiches, water, and soft drinks. ART IN THE PARK INSERT CONTEST

It's time again for our annual contest to come up with a design for this year's SV Herald "Art in the Park" insert contest. This is the design that we will also be using for our posters and all of the other AitP advertising material for 2019, so it needs to be adaptable to different formats – from square to somewhat vertical. We are looking for an image that is bold, bright and colorful and that evokes the spirit of Art in the Park. There will be lettering on the final versions of the design, but unless you choose to use some of the lettering as an integral part of the design, you do not need to bother with it at all, beyond maybe indicating where it might go. You can do your design either digitally or with traditional media. If you choose to do it digitally, the file size needs to be large enough to produce a good print at an 11 x 17 size. If it is done with traditional media, you will need to be able to submit either the original art or a high resolution photo of it.

There will be a binder at the Gallery with an assortment of past insert covers and/or posters so that you can get a better idea of what it might look like and what is required.

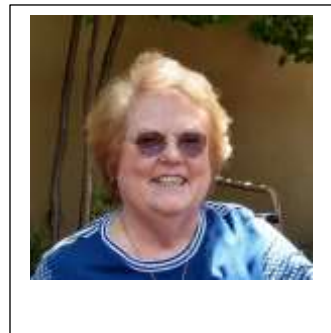

Several techniques will be covered, pen and ink, wet-in-wet, dry brush - lots of texture. Step-by-step instructions and this class is suitable for beginners.

Most everything required will be supplied (paint, paper, brushes, photo reference, etc.). You should bring a water container; a Cool Whip tub (or the equivalent) is a good size. Bring an old bath towel or dish towel to cover your work table. Not everyone will use one but I find that it is nice to have a towel handy for water issues. And paper towels; I like Viva brand because they are very absorbent (but bring whatever you have). Bring your lunch. If you have some watercolor paints, brushes or supplies bring them along, this will be a good time to play with them. Don't worry if you are a beginner, there will several of you who have no experience at all. Plan to learn and have a good time, this is going to be fun, fun, fun.

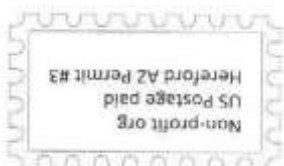
