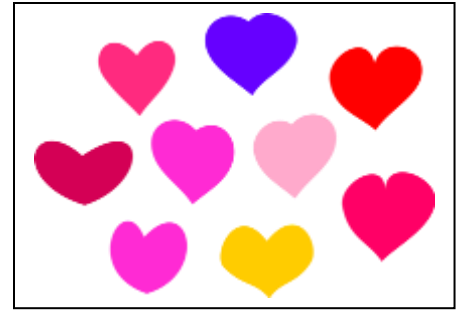

The second prize went to Christopher Vedvick for a still life photograph depicting the conflicts and coping skills developed and used by post deployment combat veteran. The third prize went to Sue Thatcher for a painting called "Old Glory and the Arizona Desert" Congratulations to all of you!

I also want to congratulate those HAA members whose work was selected for inclusion in the "Mirage2018"- the literary and arts magazine that is put out annually by Cochise College. Rod Stevens, Elizabeth Riordon, Martha Sprenkle and Jose Ponce de Leon all submitted work and had it accepted for publication. The magazine is now out, and some were delivered to the gallery, but if you did not get to see it, some copies are probably still available at the College.

Also at the College, it's still not too late to sign up to be a volunteer helper at the 4th annual Youth Arts Festival, which will take place there from 10am – 3pm on Sat., Feb 23rd. Watercolor Workshop with Pat Dunbar

Several techniques will be covered, pen and ink, wet-in-wet, dry brush - lots of texture. Step-by-step instructions and this class is suitable for beginners.

Most everything required will be supplied (paint, paper, brushes, photo reference, etc.). You should bring a water container; a Cool Whip tub (or the equivalent) is a good size. Bring an old bath towel or dish towel to cover your work table. Not everyone will use one but I find that it is nice to have a towel handy for water issues. And paper towels; I like Viva brand because they are very absorbent (but bring whatever you have). Bring your lunch. If you have some watercolor paints, brushes or supplies bring them along, this will be a good time to play with them. Don't worry if you are a beginner, there will several of you who have no experience at all. Plan to learn and have a good time, this is going to be fun, fun, fun.

Pat is best known today for her watercolor floral paintings. She came to appreciate the spontaneity and excitement that happens when adding water to pigment. In her opinion, "this illusive medium is always an exciting challenge". Pat finds that watercolor, although considered by most to be a difficult loose and fluid medium, also allows her to use a dry brush technique in a tightly controlled way that lends itself to developing images with strong colors and form that she finds a exciting. "I am amazed at what happens on my palette and paper when water and paint start doing their thing".

She continues to explore the versatile medium further, learning more about glazing, loose wet-in-wet and "negative" space techniques.

Dunbar believes "painting is a continuing learning process with growth and fulfillment being the reward"

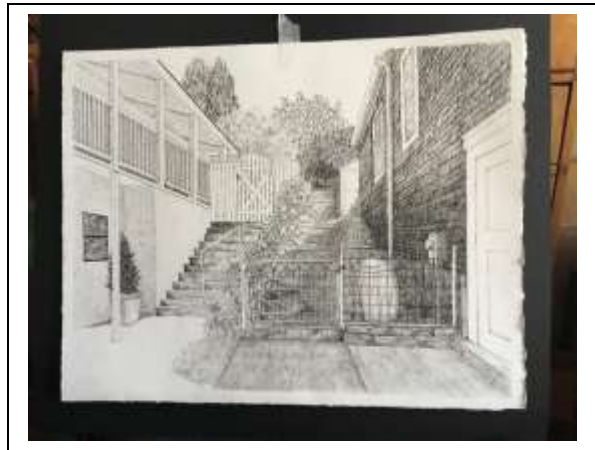

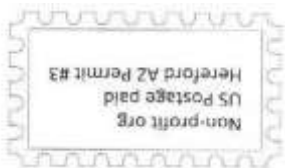
