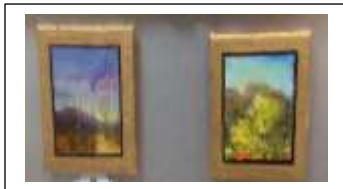

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Happy October, Artyfolks!

The time is nigh for you and I

To be off to the Park

To sell, sell, sell, or buy, buy buy.

Or both. If you think that sounds like a tawdry, mercenary, self-serving appeal intended to liberate you from your hard earned lucre, well, perhaps you're right. But I prefer to think of it as a win-win for everybody, because there's so much great stuff to be had at Art in the Park – lots of things that you're not likely to find anywhere else. And because you are buying directly from the artists, with no commission being paid to a third party, the prices are really good too. So I hope that you all will take advantage of this golden opportunity to start your holiday shopping early, even if, like me, you are just shopping for yourself. And if Art in the Park is your first stop of the holiday shopping season, I suggest making the HAA Gallery your second stop. This month's Miniature Art Show is where you'll find lots of items that are unique and lovely, small and easy to ship. Please take note: This October reception is actually happening on September 28, due to the fact that we will all be in the park on October 5.

Looking ahead, in addition to the Symphony Project, we have been offered two more opportunities to display our work around town. One is at the Mall, where they have installed a very large temporary wall over the opening where the indoor entrance to the Sears store used to be. They'd like to cover that with canvas, and have invited us to produce some artwork to go on it, so as to brighten up that end of the Mall. The idea is that the work would stay up there for a period of time, or until the retail space was occupied, at which time the art would be removed and auctioned off, with the proceeds going to the artists. Which is why we are thinking that, rather than one big picture, we might divide the canvas up into some smaller pieces of varying sizes that could be worked on separately by participating artists, and then reassembled on the wall, ala Mondrian. Because they cannot guarantee the security of the work, it can't be hung in frames, so everything will have to be firmly affixed to the wall, perhaps with staples, and then maybe with lath or some other material covering the staples. As you might have guessed, we haven't got it all figured out yet, but we should have more info to share next month. Also next month, we should have more details about the other offer we've had, the one about displaying work at the Cochise College Center for Lifelong Learning, located in the building on Wilcox that used to be the SV Regional Hospital. In the meantime, since I can't think about Art in the Park and chew gum at the same time, we'll get back to you on all of that later.

Hope to see you at the Park!

"Water" Demonstration by Camille Painter-Davis

This demo will teach ways to paint water using acrylic paint and make it look real. This will include waterfalls, waves, rapids and mirror-like reflections on placid, still water.

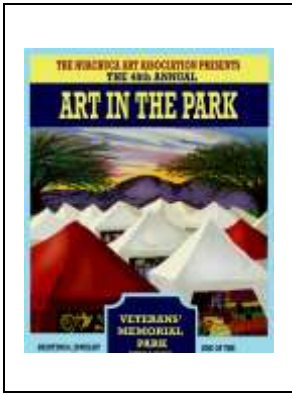


November Student Art Show
