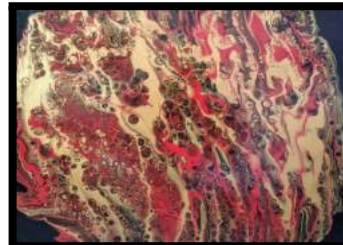
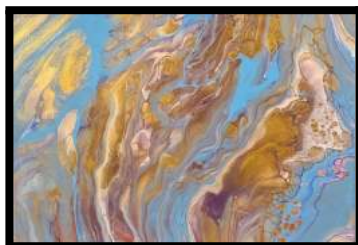

All About Our Featured Artist, Ernestine Cannady

Ernestine Cannady was born in St. Louis, Missouri but relocated to Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania as a young child. She lived most of her life in Pittsburgh until moving to Sierra Vista, Arizona in November of 2020. Ernestine is a woman of great faith and prayer who is an active member of Shiloh Christian Ministries in Sierra Vista. She is a long-time seamstress and crafter. In recent years, Ernestine tried her hand at Acrylic Pour Painting and fell in love with the art. Her beautiful and unique abstract paintings are made with love as well as great skill. She is now an award winning artist and you can find her creatively stunning pieces at the Huachuca Art Association in Sierra Vista, Arizona.



All About Our Featured Artist, Pam Chandler



Pam Chandler is a local photographer, jewelry maker, life coach, member of the Huachuca Art Association, and holds a degree in nursing. Pam has been an avid photographer since 1982 when she was gifted an antique Kodak Retina. While she has taken thousands of photos, she didn't take her photography seriously until doing a photo shoot of Show Low, Arizona in 2021. The photos were fantastic and it fueled the idea of taking her photography to the next level. Thus, Humble Daisy Photography was created and Pam has been showing her photos locally ever since. She joined the Huachuca Art Association in October of 2022, and has entered local photo competitions- winning second, third, and honorable mention placings for her work.



Her beading journey started in 1992, when she discovered that a friend made beaded jewelry as a hobby. The two got together, and Pam was hooked on the fun and creativity of beading. As an avid learner, Pam started taking beading classes with Shirley Bovis, a local expert from Tombstone's Bovis Bead Company, as well as learning wrapping techniques from Johanna Shipley from Prescott, Arizona. Currently Knot by Knot specializes in jewelry design, repair, jewelry redesign, and pearl restringing. Pam continues to take classes, give classes, and is always learning new skills and techniques to apply to her bead art.

You can do your design either digitally or with traditional media. If you choose to do it digitally, the file size needs to be large enough to produce a good print as a 11x17 size. If it is done with traditional media, you will need to be able to submit either the original art or a high resolution photo of it.

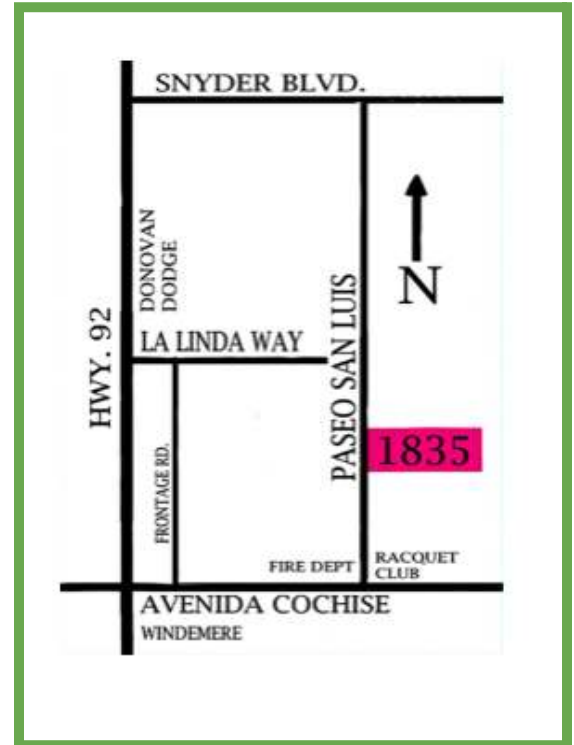

Application requirements:

1. The applicant must be a graduating senior residing in one of either the Sierra Vista, Benson, St. David, Bisbee, or Tombstone School Districts, who will be enrolled and majoring in a visual arts program at a college, technical, or trade school for at least one full year, starting no later than the Fall semester, 2024.
2. The applicant must submit a portfolio of 5-8 pieces of artwork for evaluation by the Huachuca Art Association's Scholarship Committee, and must certify that the art is his or her own original work. The work, along with the completed application should be delivered to the HAA Gallery and Art Center location at 1835 Paseo San Luis, Sierra Vista, 85635 during regular business hours (Tuesday through Saturday, 11am-5pm) and may be picked up when the selection is over. If that time is not convenient, email me, Liz Horning at: Lhorningfa19@gmail.com , or call me at 520-803-7157 to make other arrangements.
3. The applicant must submit an essay of 300 - 450 words explaining why he or she wants to major in art and describing his or her career objectives.
4. The applicant must provide three reference letters, at least one of which must be from a faculty member who is familiar with the applicant's educational background, skills, and academic record.
5. The applicant must be a legal resident of Arizona.
6. The applicant must agree, upon request, to provide a copy of his or her high school transcripts.

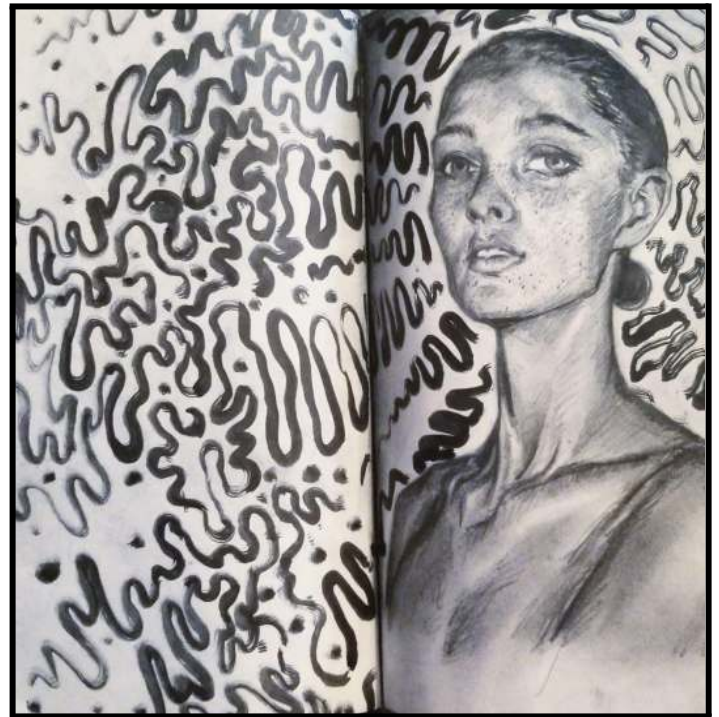

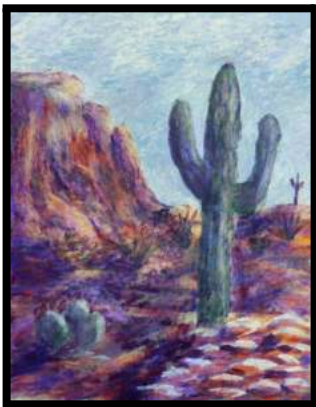
