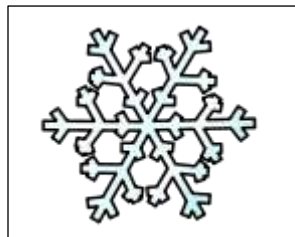
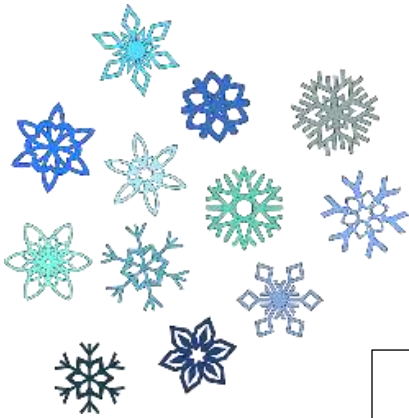

Dec 26th Bring home Art**

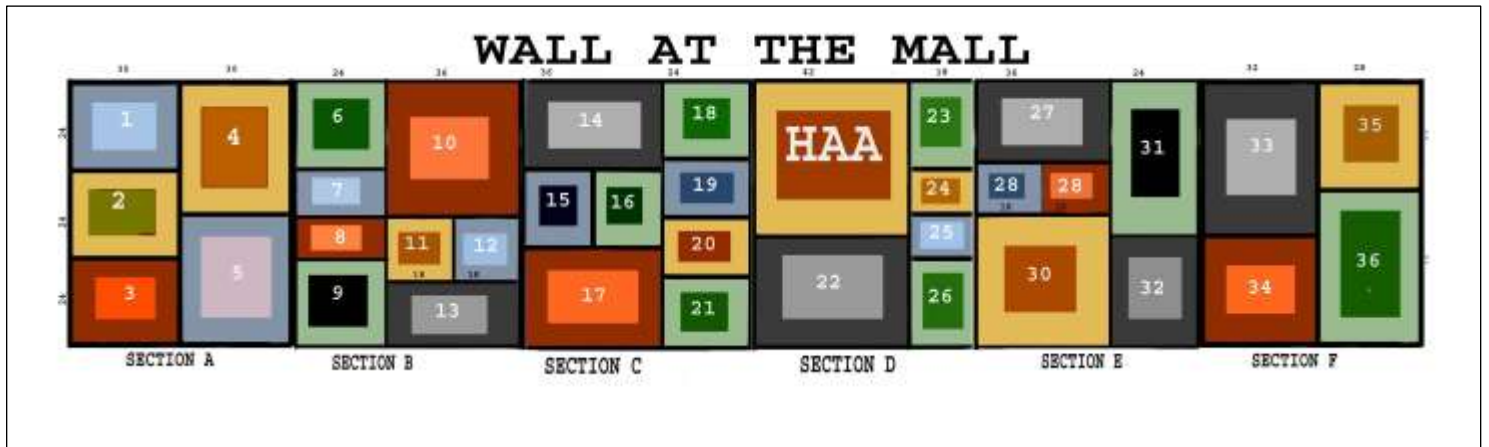
Ho,ho,ho, Artyfolks, I can't believe it's that time already, but here we are. It's time to trot out the tinsel again. The tree is already up in the Gallery, and gathering ornaments. The annual HAA Meeting/Holiday Party/ Turkey Dinner will be held at the Gallery on Sunday, December 15, from 12 to 2pm, and I hope that lots of you are able to come, bring a guest if you like, bring a dish to share, and cast your ballot for next year's Board members. You'll find the ballot elsewhere in this ArtyFacts. Please cut it out and bring it with you to the meeting. If you are not able to come, you can mail it to us at: HAA, 1835 Paseo San Luis, Sierra Vista, 85635. FYI. We have closed out our PO Box, as we are now able to collect our mail at our street address.

We are now ready to begin working on the canvas mural that will cover the WALL @ THE MALL. That is what we are calling the temporary panels that were put up to cover the entrance to the now closed Sears store. The area to be covered will be 6 feet high by about 32 feet long, but the good news is that we won't have to go to the Mall to work on it. Instead, the Mall management has provided canvas, which we have divided up into six sections, each of which has been further divided into four to eight pieces of different sizes and orientations. These pieces will then be painted with one of five different background colors which will serve as a "mats" for the finished art, which will later be reassembled and installed in sections on the wall, creating a huge Mondrian style mural, with a painting within each of the colored squares and rectangles. Should you choose to participate, you'll first need to select a canvas piece of the size and orientation you'd like to work with. There will be no stretching or framing needed. We will need these pieces to remain flat so that they can be installed on the wall without wrinkles or creases. Just tape off the area around where your art will be, leaving a border of at least two inches all the way around. Paint whatever you like, in whatever medium you choose, as long as it does not need to be covered with glass. Oil and acrylic would be the obvious choices, but other media might also work. Altogether we will have about 38 pieces of canvas, each of which will have a number and an arrow indicating placement and orientation. You can pick yours up at the Gallery, but there will be a sign-out sheet, and you must put your name and the piece number on it so that we will know who has what pieces. It may be that not every piece will get painted on. Some may just end up as blocks of color, but that's OK too, as the overall effect will be bold and colorful. The Mall's target date for all of this is January. It's unlikely that we'll have it all done by then, but we can start with the center sections. Those could be installed first, and then we can work our way outward. Since the Sears store is not owned by the Mall, but is the property of the Sears Corporation, it will remain vacant until it is either sold or leased, and so the mural is likely to stay up for some time to come. And when eventually it does come down, the paintings can all be either returned to the artists, or auctioned off at an event at the Mall. The Mall has also offered us free use of a vacant store window front to showcase our artwork during the month of December. While there will not be any sales made there, this is a good opportunity for us to display the variety of art that is available at the gallery, and we will be able to post a list of the artists and their contact information. And if that's not enough to keep you all busy, don't forget that the Open Judged Show is coming up in February, and that will be the time for all of us to show off our very best stuff.
