And, once again, Art in the Park was voted #1 in this year's Herald Review "Best of the Vista" competition, so it's nice to know that all that good work does not go unnoticed.

Speaking of the Herald and competitions, the postcard packets, the result of last spring's art competition conducted by the Herald and dubbed "Hues of Cochise" are now available for purchase in the gallery and in other venues around town. The deal is, the Herald covers the cost of production and, each year, a portion of the profits from the sales will go to a different non-profit organization – with this year's edition being a fundraiser for the HAA. For each packet that we sell in the gallery, we get to keep the whole \$15. For each packet that's sold elsewhere, we get a \$5 cut. Sweet! We are already starting to rake it in. Also sweet, Kathy Riebock has again put together two beautiful Gift Baskets for us to raffle off in the gallery. The drawing will be held at the Annual Meeting/Turkey Dinner on Saturday, December 17. More on that later.

So with our coffers refilled, and with the holidays just around the corner, it's on with the show(s) — starting with the First Annual Photographers' Open Show, from November 1-26. This will be our first photo show not restricted to members only, so there's likely to be a lot of pieces we haven't seen before. The reception is on November 5, and even if you can't make it that day, I hope you will find the time to stop by and check it out at some other time during the month. In December, we will be featuring minis and other small items, with the holidays in mind. So, don't forget that the gallery is a great place to find that one-of-a-kind gift item for that special person on your list — even if that special person is just you, yourself. There's no shame in that, and I'm guessing you probably deserve a special little treasure just as much as the next person.




