Come and see our Student Show!


September is our chance to show some of the cool creations that people have made as a result of our classes and workshops in the Studio.

So, I'm looking forward to the fall, and with it, coming just around the corner, is our 50th Annual Art in the Park. Always the first weekend in October, it's coming just a little earlier than usual this year due to the fact that this October starts on a Saturday. This event is always a whopping big deal for the HAA. It takes most of the year to get it organized - time well spent, as it is the biggest cash cow we've got - the one thing that pays the mortgage and keeps the lights on at the gallery. But to really make it profitable, we have to rely on volunteers, so please, please, if you can, do set aside some time on that weekend to help us out. As usual, we'll be needing people to help with the set-up on Friday, the tear-down on Sunday, and for the info booth on all days. Lois Bravo is setting up a schedule, so she can tell you what kind of help she might need and when. Most shifts last only for a couple of hours, and many hands make light work, as the old saying goes. But even if you can't be a volunteer, I hope you can take the time anyway to show up and shop. There are always lots of interesting thing to see, unique gift items, and since you are buying directly from the artists, there also are many bargains to be found. Again this year, we will be sharing the park with the City of Sierra Vista's "Wine, Beer and Spirits Festival", which will take place on that Saturday only, October 1, from 11 am - 6pm, on the south side of the park near the Fry Boulevard entrance.

Also, on the subject of fund raising, we have recently been gifted a large collection of fine artworks, both originals and prints from the Boatman family, mostly by Dale Boatman, who, in case you don't know, was pretty much the father of the HAA. Some of you who have been around for a while will remember him, or may even have taken classes from him. We are planning to have some kind of sale/auction later in the fall, but also, in advance of that, we plan to put some of it on display in the studio so that members will have an opportunity to see what's there and maybe make us some offers we can't refuse.

But in the meantime, September's featured event at the gallery will be the Student Art Show, featuring a selection of works that were created by people, some members and some not, in classes and workshops that have been held in the studio over the past year. Again, we are planning a traditional reception, buffet style, with lots of food, and we are hoping that lots of people will come and bring their friends and family. Last month's reception for the "Birds of a Feather" exhibit was a fun throwback to the gallery gatherings of the past, and we plan to continue in that direction, hoping that more and more of you will join us, and maybe bring a hot dish if you can. After all these months of social distancing, let's put the "associate" back in "association."

Divisions & Categories

Division 1: Experienced: Defined by having degree/college instruction in art/photography **or** having displayed/sold in multiple galleries and/or website(s).

Division 2: Intermediate: Defined by having private/limited instruction in art/photography **and/or** having displayed/sold in one or more galleries and/or website(s).

Division 3: Amateur: Defined by being self-taught in art/photography **and/or** not having displayed in any gallery or sold on a website(s).

Categories:

Photography: (Film & Digital): *Image must be camera captured.* Must maintain original composition of photo with only ***“minor”*** cropping and editing.

PhotoGRAPHIC Art: (Film & Digital): *Image must be camera captured.* Any photo modified from the original composition by adding/removing components, using special effects, merging/stacking multiple photos... *If not 3 or more entrants, it will be combined with Graphics category.*

Fees & Awards

This is an open photography show. There are no entry fees and no awards will be presented. This is your opportunity to show your work and skill in composition and editing.

Entry Limit: 2 entries *total* per artist *in any combination* of categories.

- If you are entering as an **EXPERIENCED** or **INTERMEDIATE**, you may not enter a photograph in the amateur category
- If you are entering as an **AMATEUR**, you may not enter a photograph in the other two categories

PLEASE SAVE THIS PAGE FOR IMPORTANT RULES, DATES & TIMES

RULES:

1. All entries must be original (taken by the person entering the photograph).
2. All entries must be **framed and "wired"** for hanging. Photo entries must be framed and matted. With the exception of gallery wraps, where appropriate.
3. All entries must "look" professionally framed, no duct tape, masking tape, packing tape, frayed/poor wiring, etc.
4. All entries must be clearly labeled on the back with the **artist's name, title, division), category, and price.**
5. All entries must be for sale. A sales commission of 20% for HAA members and 30% for non-members will be taken.
6. No Photography entry may exceed 16 inches on a side, *including* the frame. **Absolutely NO exceptions!!!**
7. The directors reserve the right to reject entries deemed inappropriate, in poor display condition or which do not comply with the above rules and must be **"family friendly"**.
8. **No entry** may be removed before the end of the show **(November 26th)**, unless *"approved"* by the directors or the entry has sold to a person who is not local and is unable to pick up at the assigned date. Sold entries will be clearly marked as *"Sold"* until picked up **November 26th and 27th.**

Entry Deadline: Entry form and photo copies of submitted work(s) (*if not a hanging gallery member*) must be received by HAA on or before **October 22, 2022.**

Absolutely no exceptions!

Receiving and Hanging: Artwork must be brought to the Huachuca Art Gallery, 1835 Paseo San Luis, Sierra Vista on **October 26th or 27th, 2022 between 11:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m.** **No late submissions will be accepted.** Artwork will be hung on **October 30, 2022.** Any deviations from these times **MUST** be arranged in advance. Call the Show Directors or HAA Gallery Directors listed below.

Critique & Reception: **Saturday, November 5th, Critiques 1:00 p.m. – 3:00p.m.**
Open House 1:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m.

Pick-up Date: **November 26th and 27th, 11:00 p.m. – 4:00 p.m.** (*All art must be picked up on one of these dates. We do not have room to store it!*)


