#### Scenic Landscape and Wildlife Photographer

My interest in photography began in middle school when I bought my first Kodak camera. I began concentrating on wildlife and scenic photography during my travels as an enlisted historian for the United States Air Force. As my skills and equipment improved I began entering local and national photography contests and ultimately taking First Place in the Strategic Air Command in the Color Scenic division.

After retiring from the service I began work as a school photographer in Idaho learning individual and family portrait, school sports and wedding photography. When my eyesight diminished to the point I could no longer properly focus film cameras I gave up photography all together for more than a decade. However, with the advent of digital photography and rapid improvement in digital SLR cameras I resumed my interest as a hobby. When I retired from fulltime work I started concentrating on artistic views of landscapes and wildlife which continues to this day. I currently have work on display in Benson, Douglas, Patagonia and Sierra Vista.

### PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Happy New Year Artyfolks,

Well, 2019 is almost a goner, although as I write this, not quite yet, and the holiday crush is still very much upon us, or at least upon me. It's this ginormous thing that is at once spiritually uplifting, merry and bright, while at the same time, bearing down like a ton and a half of Auntie Florence's rum-soaked fruitcake. So I'll try to be brief for a change. Just a few things: Please remember that, starting in January, your membership needs to be renewed. Please fill out the enclosed form and send it in, along with your annual dues. Even if you are a lifetime member, or for some other reason, don't owe any dues, we still need to keep your contact information up to date. It's not just that we love sending you stuff, but the fact is, that for bulk mail, the post office charges us a substantial extra fee for any Artyfacts that is not deliverable as addressed. So we really want to avoid that as much as possible. For the same reason, if you are a part-time resident, or if you move, please let us know ASAP any time your mailing address changes.

We still have some canvas pieces available for the Wall@theMall project, but they have been going pretty fast, so if you didn't get one, or you want another one, do drop by the studio and sign one out. If you have a piece that's finished, please leave it in the Gallery office, rolled up or attached to a backing, and labeled "Attention- Liz". Include your name, the title of the piece, and any contact info you wish to have put out there. We won't be putting prices on anything yet, as the plan is to leave the artworks up until the whole display is taken down, at which time they may either be returned to the artist, or sold at a special auction at the Mall. The target date for installation is January, so we'd like to have them finished by about Friday, January 10 if possible.

Then on Saturday, January 11, the Sierra Vista Symphony will be holding its winter concert in the Klein Center for the Performing Arts, at Buena High School. The music will be accompanied by a slide show of works by HAA artists, designed to go along with the music, and some of those works will be offered for sale during the intermission. The performance will begin at 7pm, and tickets are available at Safeway, Dillard's, the Sierra Vista Chamber of Commerce, and at the door.

And don't forget that our 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual Open Judged Show will be running from January 27- February 22. The deadline for entries will be January 17. That's the last day you will have to submit your entry form and fees. At that time, anyone who is not a regular HAA Gallery artist is also required to submit photos of the works they plan to enter. The actual artwork will need to be delivered to the Gallery on January 26.
