The updated entry forms and guidelines are available at the gallery as well as having been sent out to the membership via email; there have been some changes to the guidelines from years past, so please give them a read when you have the time; and many thanks once again to those that put in the time and effort to overhaul the Open Show rules.

Lastly, as it is a new year, I would like to gently remind everyone that, if you haven't done so already, 2026 membership fees are due, and it would be ideal if everyone who will be renewing their membership with the HAA does so by the end of January, just so we can get it squared away, and all relevant lists updated and current.

And Everyone; thank you, sincerely for being a part of our HAA community; none of this would happen without all of you. Here's to another year of fellowship and creativity; and many more to follow.

A Tribute to Our Friend & Fellow Artist

Sue Ziegler

November 2nd, 1948 – November 24th, 2025

Some people move quietly through the world and still manage to change everything around them. Sue Ziegler was one of those people.

Born in Concord, New Hampshire, educated in Boston, and ultimately rooted here in the foothills of Hereford, Arizona, Sue carried a lifetime of compassion, intelligence, and creativity everywhere she went. She dedicated her early career to children — teaching in Boston Public Schools and later guiding young minds as the Children's Librarian for the Littleton Public Library. Her love of stories, imagination, and learning became part of her fingerprint on the world.

When she and her husband Steve retired to Sierra Vista in 2004, the rest of us got lucky. Because Sue didn't retire from life. She stepped into the community with the same devotion she'd given her students. She created art, she encouraged artists, and she gave the Huachuca Art Gallery a kind of steady heartbeat — the kind that only someone who truly gets people, and truly gets life, can give. Sue was never loud about it. She didn't need to be. Her encouragement was personal. Her involvement was consistent. Her belief in the artists of this community was unwavering. She helped keep the gallery relevant, thriving, and connected — not because she wanted recognition, but because she wanted others to shine.

If you ever wondered how many lives one person can lift... the answer is: more than she ever took credit for.


In her quieter moments, Sue read voraciously, shaped beauty from gourds and quilling, and in recent years discovered a natural talent for painting — as if the universe looked at her life of service and said, "Here, try this too."

Sue leaves behind her husband and soulmate, Steve, her children, grandchildren, and extended family — all carrying her love, her humor, and her quiet strength forward. But she also leaves behind a space in the Huachuca Art Gallery that cannot simply be filled. We'll try — because she taught us to try — but there was only one Sue. And there will only ever be one. She got life right. That's not something you can say about many people. It's something we can say about her without hesitation.

So what can we do for Sue?

We honor her by lifting each other the way she lifted us. We encourage the timid artist. We show up for the community that she helped build. We celebrate creativity, kindness, and the quiet power of being good. And we keep her with us — in the work we do, the art we create, and the way we treat people.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Notice to Entrants – No more than three entries per person, regardless of division.

DIVISIONS

Division 1: Experienced: Any artist may enter at this level. Artists must enter at the experienced level if they are represented in a gallery or have won a prize ribbon in a previous HAA art show as an intermediate artist for the medium being submitted.

Division 2: Intermediate: The artist is not represented in a gallery, and has not won a “prize” ribbon at the intermediate level in a previous HAA art show for the media being entered. Emerging artists are welcome in this category.

Notice to Youth Entrants – No more than two entries per person, regardless of division.

YOUTH DIVISIONS

Division 1: Ages 14-17

Division 2: Ages 8-13

CATEGORIES – Note: If an applicant enters under the wrong category, or if there are fewer than three different applicants in any one category, the entry will be shown in the next most appropriate category at the discretion of the show director. All such decisions are final.

WALL ART (Hanging Media): Oil, acrylic, mixed media, watercolor, pastel, and graphics (pencil, colored pencil, pen and ink, pyrography, and other hanging art at the discretion of the show director). No quilts.

PHOTOGRAPHY: Images must be camera-captured, maintain much of their original composition (limited cropping), and show only minimal editing.

PHOTOGRAPHIC ART: Images must be camera-captured. Any photograph modified from the original composition by adding/removing components, using special effects, merging/stacking multiple photos (astronomical or high dynamic range [HDR]).

TABLE ART and JEWELRY will not be divided into divisions.

TABLE ART: All Gourd Art, Clay/Ceramic, Wood Craft, Glass Art, Metal, Other 3-D Art approved by Gallery and/or Show Director.

JEWELRY: Metal, Wirework, Beaded

FEES & AWARDS

Fee: \$10 per entry for HAA members. \$15 per entry for non-members, and \$5 per youth entrant (17 or younger). **All entry fees are nonrefundable. Note: If you are mailing your entry form, you must include your entry fee. Entry forms received without payment are not valid and will not be accepted.**

Awards: “**Best of Show**” - \$125. “**Mayor’s Award**” - \$50 in both divisions. “**People’s Choice Award**” - \$50. Wall Art, Photography, Photographic Art - **Experienced:** 1st - \$50, 2nd - \$40, 3rd - \$30. Wall Art, Photography, Photographic Art - **Intermediate:** 1st - \$30, 2nd - \$20, 3rd - \$10. Table Art: 1st - \$50, 2nd - \$40, 3rd - \$30; Jewelry: 1st - \$50, 2nd - \$40, 3rd - \$30. **Youth awards will consist of ribbons only.** Honorable mention ribbons will also be awarded at the judge’s discretion. ***The judge’s decisions are final.***

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: Questions about this show should be forwarded to the Show Director. Call the Huachuca Art Gallery during normal business hours, 11 am – 5 pm Tuesday through Saturday. Ask that your question be forwarded to Lori Giliberto, Show Director.

IMPORTANT RULES, DATES, AND TIMES

(Absolutely no AI Art or AI Photographs allowed!)

1. All entries must be original and never previously judged in competition at any previous HAA judged art show.
2. All entries must be **framed and “wired” for hanging**. Photographs must be framed and matted.
EXCEPTION: Gallery Wraps, Photographs printed on acrylic or metal.
3. All entries must appear professionally framed. Use of duct tape, masking tape, packing tape, or frayed/poor wiring is not permitted. Wiring must adequately support the weight of the piece. **Absolutely NO wet or tacky paint allowed.**
4. All entries must be **clearly labeled** on the back for Wall Art and Photography. Large tags or cards for Gourds, Clay/Ceramics, Wood Craft, Glass Art, and Jewelry with the **artist's name, title, division** (not applicable for Table Art or Jewelry), **category**, and **price**.
5. All entries (including youth) must be for sale. A sales commission of 20% for HAA members and 30% for non members will be taken.
6. No Wall Art and Photography entry may exceed 36 inches on a side, ***including the frame. Absolutely NO exceptions!***
7. The directors reserve the right to reject entries deemed inappropriate, in poor display condition, or which do not comply with all the above rules. All artwork must be “family friendly”.
8. **No entry may be removed** before the end of the show (**February 27th**), unless “approved” by the directors or the entry has sold to a person who is not local and is unable to pick up at the assigned date. Sold entries will be clearly marked as “SOLD” until picked up on **February 28th**.

Each jewelry piece must come with its own display stand, labeled with the artist's name, so it can be returned if the piece is sold.

ENTRY DEADLINE: The completed entry form, payment, and photographs (front and back, showing hanging wire) of each submitted work must be received by **5 p.m. January 24, 2026**. **Late entries will not be accepted – no exceptions.**

RECEIVING AND HANGING: Artwork must be delivered to the Huachuca Art Gallery, 1835 Paseo San Luis, Sierra Vista, on **January 31st, 2026, between 12:00 and 4:00 p.m. NO EARLY DROP-OFFS**. Artwork will be hung on **February 1st, 2026**. Any deviation from these times **MUST** be arranged in advance by calling the Show Director or HAA Gallery Director.

JUDGING: Saturday, February 7th, 8:00 – 11:00 AM

CRITIQUE & RECEPTION: Saturday, February 7th, Critique: 1:00-3:00 PM. Reception/Open House: 3:00-5:00 PM

PICK-UP DATE: Sunday, February 28th, 12:00 – 3:00 PM (All art must be picked up on this date. We do not have space to store your art).

Complete the attached entry form, and **print legibly**.

If your writing is unreadable, we cannot create your exhibit cards.

Youth entries must include the full name, address, email address, and phone number of the parent, guardian, or sponsor. If a youth entry is sold, the check will be made out to the parent or guardian.

Wire Wrapping with Naomi Blackwell

Naomi will be demonstrating how to turn various shapes and sizes of un-drilled stones into wearable jewelry by creating frames and settings using Copper Wire. Come and see her process, and ask any questions you might have about how this kind of jewelry is made.



ACRYLIC CLASS with Elaine Wells

Elaine will teach ways to use acrylic paint that creates depth with value variation and harmony through color blending and glazing. We will do a landscape painting in this manner or you're welcome to bring a photo of your choice from which to paint. We will discuss composition, balance, color, value and much more.


