


All About Our Featured Artist, Amanda Bethard



1st Sunday will be a lecture and micro study. **2nd Sunday** will be a still life or live clothed model. **3rd Sunday** will be a continuation of the last class.

Class will take a deep dive into mastery level techniques with more advanced topics such as planar shapes, 3pt perspective and the nature of light; refraction, fresnel, inverse square law and reflected highlights. Students would be encouraged to build a portfolio of sketches to show their growth. This class promises to be a challenge for those looking to make a noticeable improvement in their skills.

Introduction to Plein Air

with Nathaniel Zoret-Russell

Everyone in attendance is encouraged to bring what they need for plein air, whether it be water colors, cameras, oil paint or just graphite. If you are working in a 2D medium a light easel would be necessary unless you are working out of a small sketchbook that can easily be setup on your lap or held in one hand. Having a hook on your eisel can be helpful as you can suspend your bag from it to both keep insects out and weigh down your setup. I would suggest not bringing a ground (canvas, sketchbook or paper) any larger than 36 inches on any side as the wind can be unrelenting and it will limit your enjoyment. We'll be meeting at the gallery to discuss our setups, possible locations and times.
